- Floriculture can be evolved as viable and profitable alternative which has potential to generate remunerative self-employment and have prospects for providing economical sustainability.
- Arunachal Pradesh can be right fully called "Orchid Paradise" of our country. Over 600 species of orchids can be found in the state.
- The state can contribute significantly to the orchid industry in the country and also encouraging the entrepreneurs for commercial cultivation of the orchid will improve the socio-economic status of the people in the state.

Cultivation and conservation of RET orchid species and economically important species.


Establishing satellite units in selected villages with a view to promote orchid based entrepreneurship in rural areas.

Establishment of Germplasm Unit

The centre has developed and established the Orchid Germplasm Unit, which is working towards the conservation of the indigenous varieties of orchids that have been rescued or collected from areas of deforestation. Around 100 species of orchids have been collected and are maintained.

Plant tissue culture laboratory established and protocols standardized for conservation and mass propagation of orchids with commercial values.















Establishment of State-of-the-Art Orchidarium

State-of-the-Art Orchidarium measuring around 600 sqm with all the has been established. It consists of around 6000 types of orchids consisting of important commercial varieties Dendrobium, Cymbidium, Vanda, Oncidium, Mokara, Cattleya, Phalaenopsis. The state of art orchidarium will works towards propagation and commercialization of important commercial orchids to provide economic avenues to the local populace.





Establishment of Orchid Production Unit/ Satellite Units

Orchid Production/Satellite units have been established in different parts of Arunachal Pradesh (Namsai, Pasighat, Kimin, Khach Neelam and Ziro). Around 350 varieties of important commercial orchids have been supplied to each individual unit.
